

Search & Say every

Preparation: Show your student in his/her text, the sentence containing this word. Then show this page.

1. Say, "This is the word 'every.'" Give examples: "Every day. I looked at every pony. Every."
2. Show your student one line at a time. (You might move an index card down the page as you go.)
3. Say, • "Find the word 'every.'" • Put your finger under it (Point to it). • Say 'every.'"
4. Say "Yes!" or "Right!" or similar to signal a correct response. If your student misses, say "Look again."

Follow-thru: Re-read from the student's text, the sentence containing this word.
