Preparation: Show your student in his/her text, the sentence containing this word. Then show this page.

- 1. Say, "This is the word 'should." Give examples: "Should I help you? I should feed the fish. Should."
- 2. Show your student one line at a time. (You might move an index card down the page as you go.)
- 3. Say, "Find the word 'should." Put your finger under it (Point to it). Say 'should."
- 4. Say "Yes!" or "Right!" or similar to signal a correct response. If your student misses, say "Look again." Follow-thru: Re-read from the student's text, the sentence containing this word.
